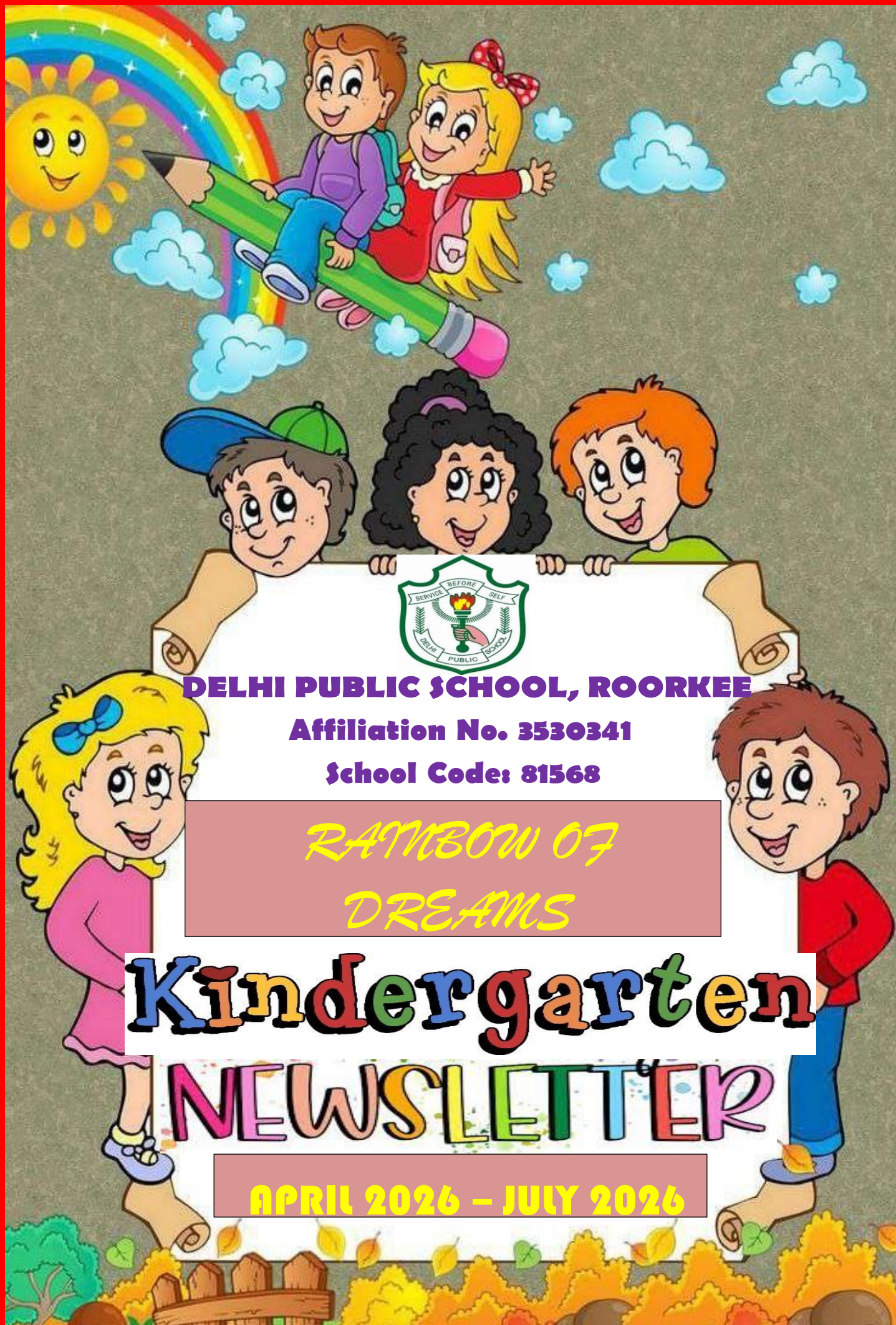

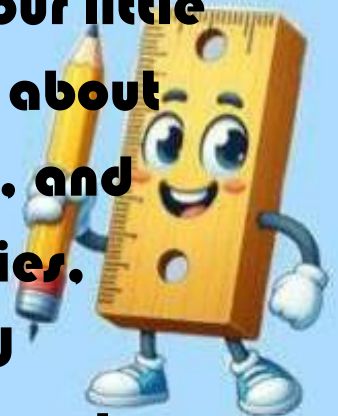

SKILL DEVELOPMENT CLASSES

Skill development classes help children learn in a fun and engaging way. Through activities like storytelling, games and art, young learners build essential skills in reading, writing and communication. These classes also boost confidence, creativity, and social interaction, creating a strong foundation for future learning while making education enjoyable.





The MOVE LIKE THE ZOO CREW activity was conducted to develop gross motor skills, body awareness, balance and coordination. Students enthusiastically imitated animal movements such as frog jumps, duck walks, elephant stomps and rabbit hops. Through this activity, students demonstrated improved physical fitness, better body control and an understanding of different animal movements.



The **"LITTLE HANDS, BIG FOCUS"** activity turned learning into a fun and energetic challenge for young learners. With colourful cones and rings, children eagerly raced to match and pick the correct objects, boosting their eye - hand coordination along the way. This exciting activity sharpened their focus improved concentration and encouraged self-control and quick thinking—all while keeping them happily engaged and active.



"BACKWARD COUNTING" activity was organized to develop students' physical activity and co-ordination. In this activity, flash cards with numbers were placed on the stairs and students were asked to read the number in reverse order while jumping from one number to the next. This activity helped students practice backward counting in a hands-on manner. The students demonstrated enthusiasm and improved mathematical learning.



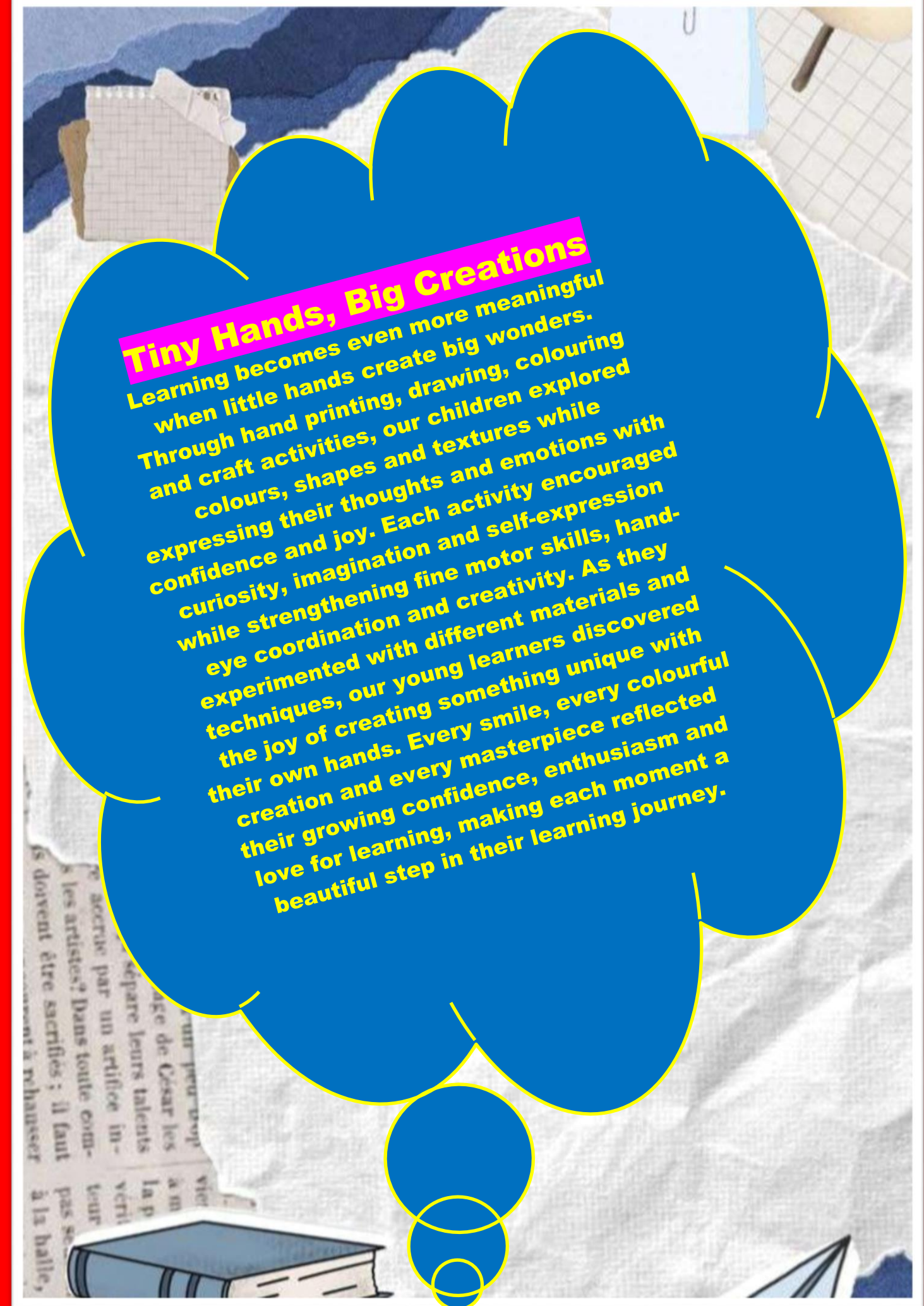
"SHABD RACHNA" activity was organized to develop vocabulary skills among young minds. This activity was conducted in a fun and interactive manner. Students were shown a picture and asked to pick a word flash card that matched the picture. Once they picked the flashcard, they had to read the word. Students demonstrated excellent vocabulary and word-building skills. Students showed great enthusiasm and interest in the activity.



"CLAP YOGA" activity is not just clapping – it is fun exercise for our hands, brain and heart! When children clap in different rhythms and with different movements, it improves blood flow, strengthens fingers and sharpens focus. It's like giving our brain a happy massage!



"SIMON SAYS" through this game, children followed instructions only when they heard "Simon Says". This helped them improve listening skills, attention, self-control and quick decision-making. It also supported gross motor development as kids jumped, clapped, touched body parts and moved around. The activity kept children active, alert and full of energy. They enjoyed following commands, laughing together and learning to wait for the right instruction.



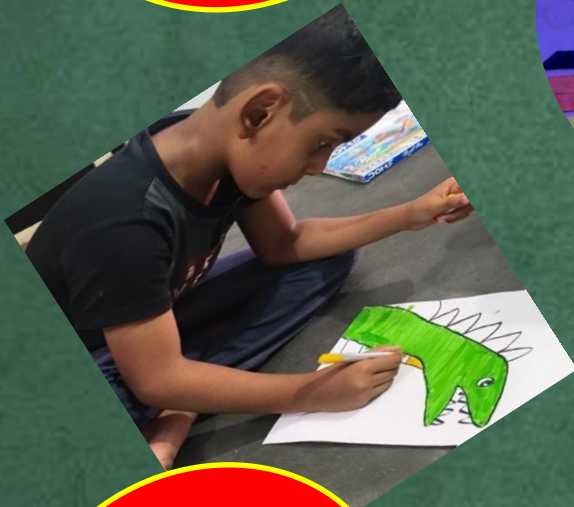
Tiny Hands, Big Creations

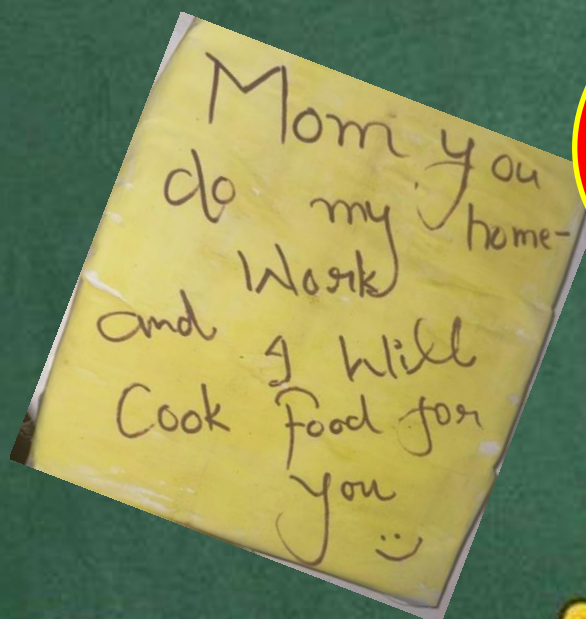


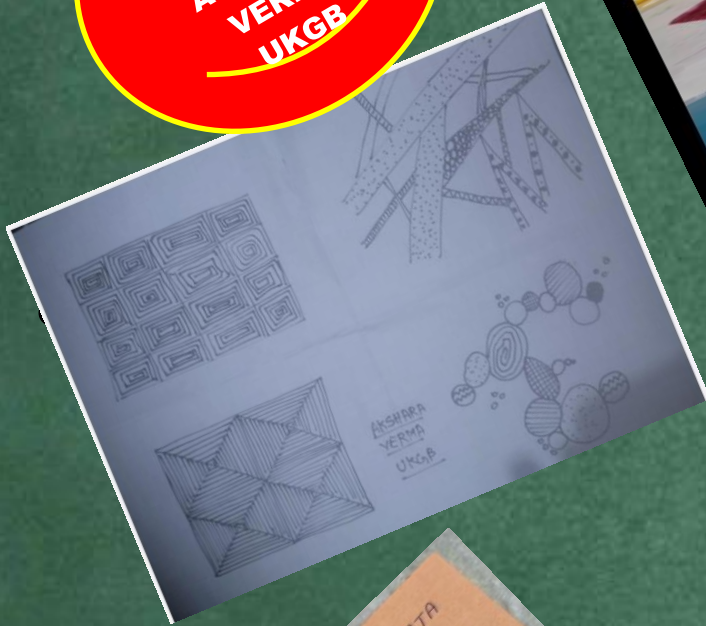
