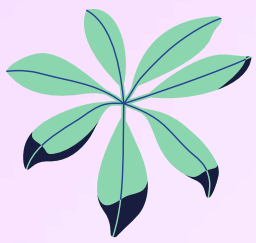
## MASK - O- MANIA ACTIVITY

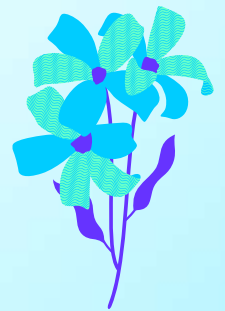




# Nature Art Fiesta

"मैं तुम्हें एक मजेदार गाय दिखाऊँ!"

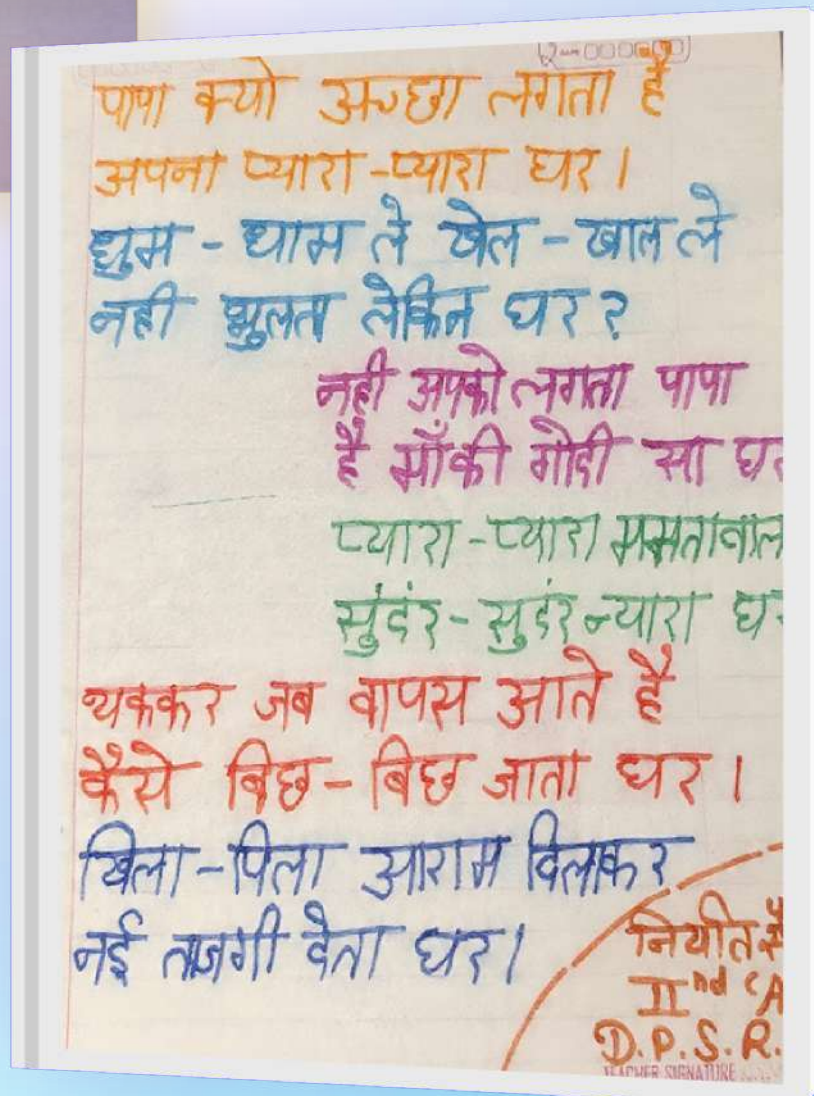
